



Position Announcement Adjunct Instructor

Athens Technical College in Athens, Georgia, seeks Adjunct Instructors for various positions and locations. The main campus is located in Athens with a satellite campus in Elberton and centers in Greene and Walton. Adjunct instructors are responsible to the Program Director/Coordinator for fulfilling both teaching and non-teaching activities. Moreover, instructors will use appropriate techniques to provide students with the knowledge needed to successfully achieve the learning outcomes as described in each course syllabus. Positions are part-time (adjunct) on various campuses.

Athens Technical College is a multi-campus, two-year degree granting institution, a unit of the Georgia System of Technical Colleges, and is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award the associate degree.

Qualifications: The competitive applicant will need to demonstrate their academic preparation and in most circumstances provide evidence of their credentials. Extensive work experience is desired along with some background in teaching/training. Positions vary on multiple campuses. **Please check with the appropriate program Director/Coordinator for availability of classes and proper qualifications.**

Salary and Benefits: This position offers part-time employment. Salary is competitive based on education and experience.
