Duties:

Under general supervision demonstrates the use of appropriate teaching techniques. Demonstrates the use of appropriate testing and grading procedures including proper maintenance of grade books and any other appropriate record-keeping requirements. Demonstrates the effective use of oral and written communication skills and knowledge of current procedures in the Nursing field. Follows approved curriculum standards and course syllabi. Monitors student use of supplies, materials, and equipment. Advises and counsels students and maintains appropriate advisement records on each student. Maintains classrooms and laboratories in accordance with approved classroom and lab management plans. Attends meetings as required. Observes and enforces the institution's policies and regulations. Assists with student recruitment and job placement. Serves on committees. Maintains qualifications for employment as described by the Department of Technical and Adult Education Policy Manual and accreditation standards. Follows rules and regulations as described by the Department of Technical and Adult Education Policy Manual and other policies and procedures established by the institution.

Qualifications:

Must hold R.N. licensure in the State of GA and three years paid work experience in-field within past seven years. Appropriate degree will reflect the requirements of college accrediting agencies and state and/or national licensing boards. Work experience must include the competencies, skills and knowledge levels that the instructor will be expected to teach. Occupational experience must meet the current requirements of the appropriate licensing boards for the area of instruction. Must demonstrate excellent written and verbal communication skills. Must possess and maintain the appropriate professional credential for or related to the field or position.

Salary:

Salary for this position is commensurate with education and experience.
