POLICY:

To the maximum extent feasible, the technical colleges shall maintain academic standards that are uniformly applied among all students. Absent extraordinary circumstances, all students must be provided a copy of the course syllabus for each class by the end of the first whole week of class for every term.

Academic misconduct, as defined in the Student Code of Conduct, such as cheating, or misconduct at a clinical site, must be addressed according to a student under the Code of Student Conduct in addition to any loss of academic credit or standing that may result from having failed to meet a course's academic requirements.
