## HAPEVILLE CHARTER MIDDLE SCHOOL

Grades 6, 7 and 8

In addition to Reading, Language Arts, Social Studies, and Physical Education/Health courses, each Hapeville Charter School student attending grades 6, 7 and 8 will enroll in:

- Mathematics courses using the Connected Mathematics Project, or CMP, developed and implemented through Michigan State University.
- Science track courses using the Foundational Approaches in Science Teaching (FAST), developed and implemented through the University of Hawaii.
- Spanish language courses in preparation for Spanish II at the 9th Grade level. Emphasis on Spanish language acquisition begins at the 6th Grade level and is required each subsequent year.
- Enrichment courses which will include curriculum content areas focusing on career awareness and development.

CAREER ACADEMY

Hapeville Charter Career Academy, founded in 2009, is a college preparatory independent charter high school approved by, and operating within, the Fulton County School System. Twenty-three units are required for graduation and will include the following:

English/Language Arts	4 units
Mathematics	4 units
Science	4 units
Social Sciences	4 units
Health/PE	1 unit
World Language and/or Fine Arts	3 units
Electives	4 units

(World Language and certain Electives are sometimes combined.)

Through a partnership with Atlanta Technical College, HCCA students may enroll in one or more of the following dual enrollment curriculum areas:

1. Auto Technology (Students can qualify for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification.)
2. Avionics Technician
3. Basic Dental Assisting
4. Criminal Justice Technology
5. Patient Care Assisting

In order to participate in the dual enrollment program, a student must achieve the following minimum scores on the ASSET assessment:

Writing	38
Reading	38
Math	35

The postsecondary tuition costs for students who qualify to participate in the dual enrollment courses are paid through the State of Georgia HOPE Grant.
