- Limited healthcare services



- 38 primary care offices (5 school Clinics)
- More than 120 clinicians
- Over 250 support staff (nurses, front office receptionists).

Patients and Visits at School Clinic

January 2018- December 2018

- 562 Unique (Unduplicated) students
- 2173 visits
- Type of Visits
 - 1330 : sick visits
 - 486 : Health Checks
 - 404: immunization visits
 - 92 : sports physical visits



Outcomes: Clinical Quality

January 2018- December 2018

- 469 students: Nutritional Counseling and Physical Activity Counseling
- 212 Students: depression screening
- 21 students were Tobacco users and all were given tobacco cessation advice (100%)



Free Vision Screening and Glasses

- Free Vision screenings and glasses event
- 151 children screened
- Free glasses were given to 30 children









Chattahoochee Valley Academy

- A Georgia College and Career Academy housed within Chattahoochee County Middle-High School
- Second year of operation
- Over 60% of high school students are enrolled in College and Career Ready courses
- Five certificate programs, 23 college level core classes
- 65% of students are military dependent
- Majority of the local, non-military students live at or near the poverty level

- Creating local health care work-force in rural community
- Internships (in partnership with Columbus Tech. College)
- Teaching formal ancillary health care courses
