




Georgia's Labor Market

- The Georgia Department of Labor reported during the peak of the pandemic, the unemployment rate reached 12.6%. As of August, the unemployment has decreased to 5.6%. This shows steady progression in job recovery.
- Commissioner Butler stated as of early September, nearly 151,000 jobs are listed online at EmployGeorgia.com for Georgians to access. This job total has more than doubled since the beginning of this pandemic, with just 73,000 jobs listed during April 2020.
- "We have recovered over 65 percent of the jobs lost since the pandemic began mid-March," said Commissioner Butler.

- Involve partners. Utilize the stakeholders, understand the needs of the employers. Involve local technical colleges, non-profit partners, and others that may be able to assist employers.
