The Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) can now provide Georgia residents with an award of up to \$200 to cover fees for a state-approved High School Equivalency (HSE) examination. The HOPE HSE Grant is available once per subject test to each eligible student who receives authorization from TCSG to take an approved examination.



Get Prepared

- Collect and have your required documents ready to upload, including a signed and notarized Affidavit of Lawful Presence.
- Ensure you have created an account on myGED.com and either complete a high school equivalency practice test or complete at least one subject area of a high school equivalency test.

Complete Application

- Visit www.HSEtest4Free.com to complete your application and upload your documents.

Application Review

- Allow up to **5 days** for your application to be processed and reviewed.

Notice of Status

- If approved, you will receive an award email notification within **2-5 business days** that contains your GED testing vouchers.
- If denied, you will receive an email notification with reasons for your denial along with contact information for application assistance.

- Remember, you have a maximum of 60 days **from completion of your GED Ready Practice Test date** to schedule and complete your GED Exam.
