An Associate's Degree in Science in Biology will give students a solid foundation in the Biological Sciences. Students who graduate from this program can also work in the biological sciences as a science technician. Science technicians use the principles and theories of science and mathematics to assist in research and development.

Bioscience programs focus on the application of the biological sciences, biochemistry, and genetics to the preparation of new and enhanced agricultural, environmental, clinical, and industrial products, including the commercial exploitation of microbes, plants, and animals. The curriculum may include instruction in bioinformatics, gene identification, phylogenetics and comparative genomics, bioinorganic chemistry, immunoassaying, DNA sequencing, xenotransplantation, genetic engineering, industrial microbiology, drug and biologic development, and enzyme-based production processes.

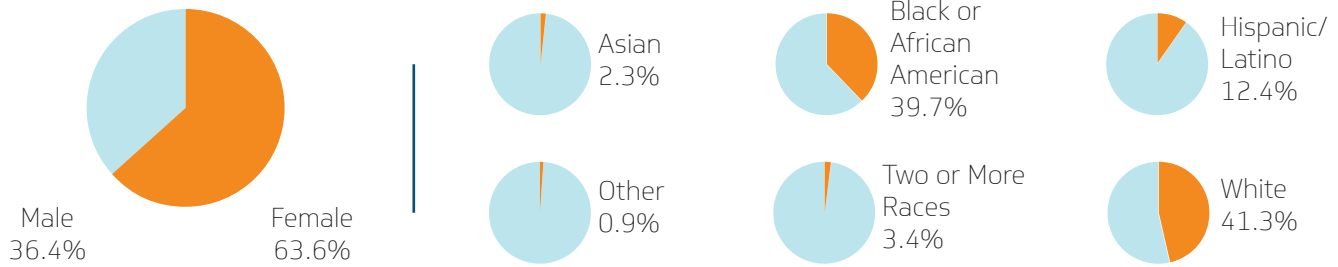

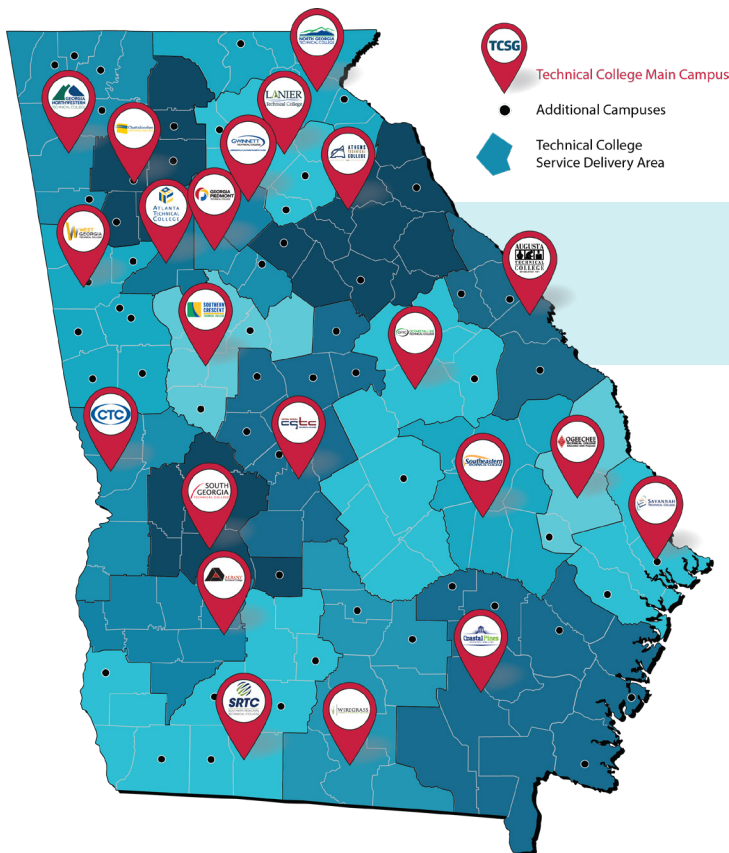


FINANCIAL AID

The HOPE Career Grant provides Free Tuition for students that enroll in one of 18 High Demand career fields. It also helps Georgia's employers by creating a pipeline of skilled workers they can hire well into the future. In addition, many technical college students of all ages in Diploma and Technical Certificate programs have unique access to tuition assistance for workforce credentials.
