

NURSES

The nursing program is a sequence of courses designed to prepare students for positions in the nursing profession. The curriculum is designed to produce highly-trained, technically-advanced, competent, and caring individuals who are prepared to practice professional nursing in a variety of health care settings. The purpose of the program is to provide the learner with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitude to practice competently and safely as a beginning nurse generalist in a variety of acute and long-term care settings. The nurse is viewed as a caring, holistic person who possesses critical-thinking/problem-solving skills, integrity, accountability, a theoretical knowledge base, refined psychomotor skills, and a commitment to life-long learning.

DEMOGRAPHICS SYSTEM OVERALL




FINANCIAL AID

The HOPE Career Grant provides Free Tuition for students that enroll in one of 18 High Demand career fields. It also helps Georgia's employers by creating a pipeline of skilled workers they can hire well into the future. In addition, many technical college students of all ages in Diploma and Technical Certificate programs have unique access to tuition assistance for workforce credentials. Georgia's HOPE Grant (a separate program from the HOPE Scholarship) is available to Georgia residents who are working towards a certificate or diploma at an eligible college in Georgia.
